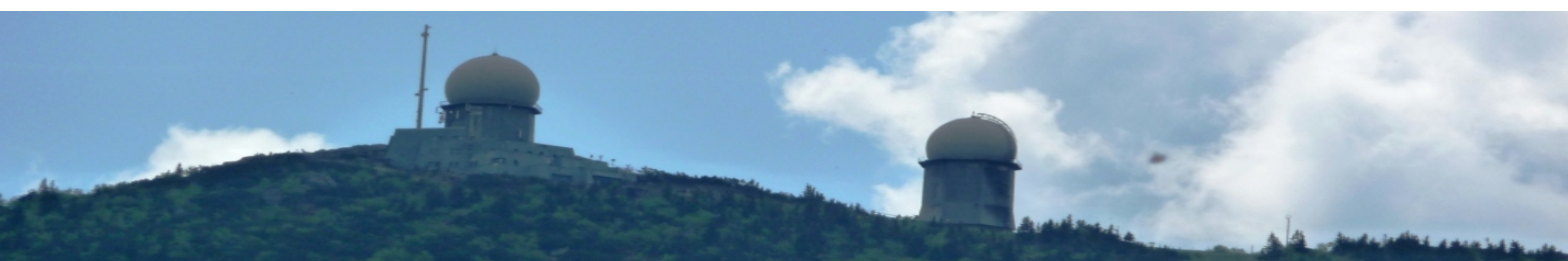

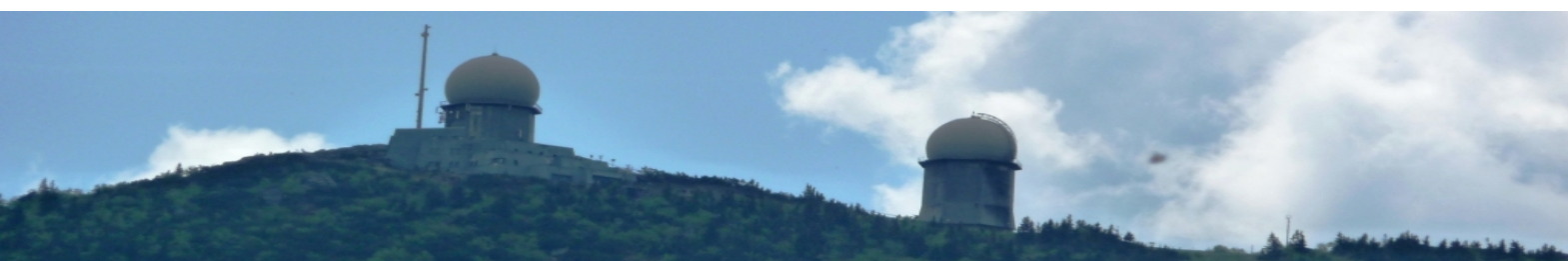

By registering, the player declares that the data and tournament results collected on the occasion of the tournament will be used to determine the DWZ and d. FIDE rating by the responsible authorities and games, photos, tournament dates, game reports and the like are published.

By registering for the tournament, the participants accept the statutes of the German Chess Federation e.V. (DSB) as binding. The principles set out in the DSB statutes include the promotion of fair chess sports and thus combating the direct and indirect use of illegal technical aids. In the event of a violation, the participants submit to the DSB's power to impose sanctions, in particular to the measures specified in §§ 55 to 61 of the DSB's statutes, and to the DSB's association jurisdiction.

Players currently banned or excluded by FIDE, the DSB or a member association of the DSB are excluded from tournament participation. In addition, the organizer reserves the right not to admit players to the tournament who have reasonable grounds to suspect that they have not behaved in accordance with the rules at a previous tournament or competition, as well as players who, through their behavior during the tournament, have reasonable grounds to suspect that they have broken the rules stand, to be excluded from the tournament with immediate effect.
