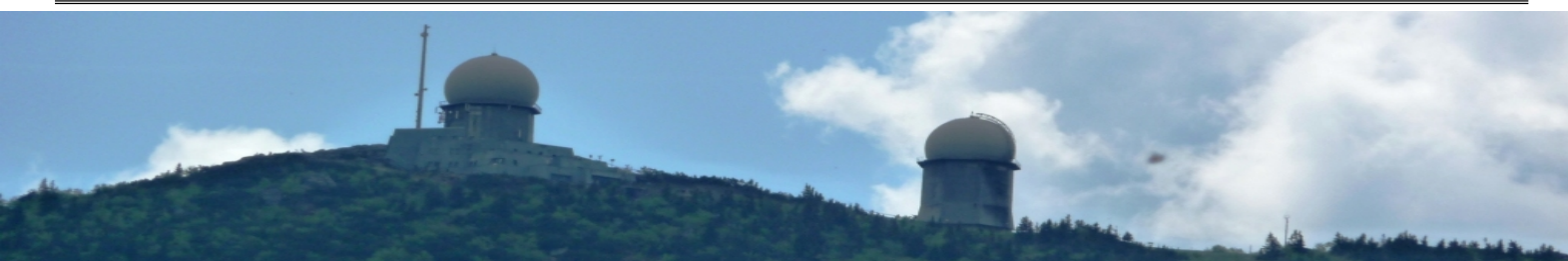

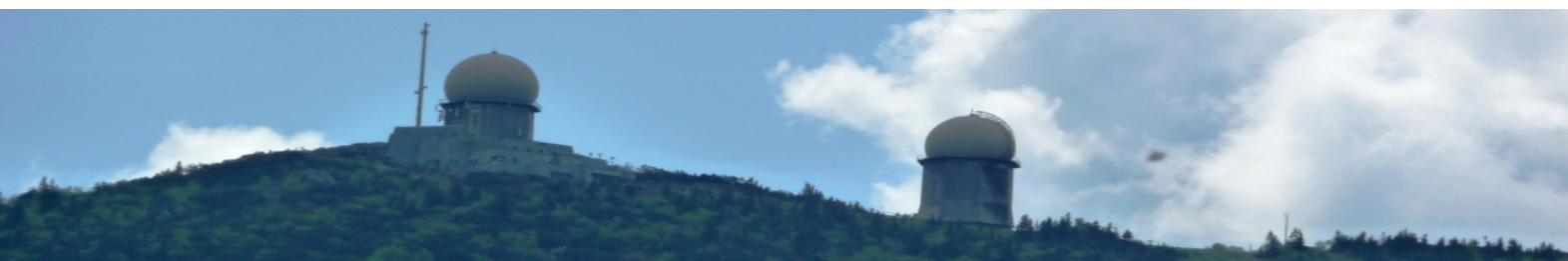

Declaration

By registering, the player declares that he agrees to the use of the data and tournament results collected on the occasion of the tournament to determine the DWZ and d. FIDE rating is approved by the responsible authorities and games, photos, tournament data, game reports and the like are published.

By registering for the tournament, participants accept the statutes of the German Chess Federation e.V. (DSB) as binding for them. The principles set out in the statutes of the DSB include the promotion of fair chess and thus also the fight against the direct and indirect use of unauthorized technical aids. In the event of a violation, the participants submit to the sanctioning power of the DSB, in particular the measures specified in Sections 55 to 61 of the DSB's statutes, and to the association jurisdiction of the DSB.

Players currently banned or excluded by FIDE, the DSB or a member association of the DSB are excluded from participating in the tournament. In addition, the organizer reserves the right not to admit players to the tournament who have reasonable grounds to suspect that they have not behaved in accordance with the rules in a previous tournament or competition, as well as players who have reasonable grounds to suspect that their behavior during the tournament has violated the rules to be excluded from the tournament with immediate effect.
